Dear **NRRPT** Applicant:

The Application for Registration and fee of \$250 (US\$) should be processed on the NRRPT website (www.nrrpt.org) by the required deadline. The Application Fee includes a Processing Fee of \$50 which is non-refundable. The application review process will not begin until the application and fee is received.

Examinations are scheduled twice a year at locations throughout the country. Typically, examinations are given in the January/February and July/August time frame. Exact exam dates and application deadlines will be posted on our web page at www.nrrpt.org or are available from the Executive Secretary at (401) 637-4811 or nrrpt@nrrpt.org. The applicant is responsible for ensuring the application and fee is submitted. A Late Fee of \$50 is required for applications postmarked after the deadline and will be required once paying online. Examination results will not be released to applicants with any fees are in arrears.

The Location Preference Form should be completed with your application. Please note that the exam locations are tentative and may change. You will be notified if the site you select will not be available.

After application and fee is received, the applications will be reviewed by an Application Review Team to verify the applicant meets examination prerequisites. Applicants will be notified as soon as the review is complete. After an applicant is approved to sit for an examination, the entire Application Fee is non-refundable. For applicants determined to be ineligible to sit for the examination, the Application Fee minus the non-refundable Processing Fee will be returned along with an explanation of their ineligibility.

The examination consists of 150 multiple choice questions designed to test the applicant's broad-based knowledge of radiation protection. Four hours are allotted to complete the examination. Exam questions are based on radiation protection practice in the United States, i.e., U.S. guidelines and regulations.

Upon notification by the **NRRPT** that a candidate was unsuccessful on the exam, they may sit for the next regularly scheduled exam or any exam thereafter for a Retake fee of \$125.

Successful examinees will be registered by the **NRRPT** and will receive a Certificate of Registration suitable for framing. Additionally, a handsome wall plaque is available.

Because of the diversity in radiation protection topics covered by the examination, extensive preparation is encouraged. The amount of preparation needed varies with the education, training, and experience of the Candidate.
